We want to wish you a wonderful 2012. This year will be another event filled year at the temple. Your presence and support is so instrumental for the temple to continue providing religious services and cultural events. We thank you for your generous support and your devotion.

**Our first event of the year is on January 14, 2012. The day will mark the celebration of Pongal/Sankranti and Lohri. Please participate and make it a truly joyous event.**

We have scheduled kite flying at 2 PM for the children. Kites and thread will be made available at the temple grounds. The fee is \$5/- for two kites and thread (first come first served). We believe we have enough kites for all to enjoy. It should be a crisp afternoon with max temperature predicted to be about 52 deg. Suresh bhai and Raju Bhai will be coordinating this effort.

This will be followed by **Satyanarayan Pooja 4-6 PM**, to be followed by a bonfire and Lohri.

**Mahaprasad will be served at 6.45 PM. Pizza** will be served to **children only** (below 16 years of age). If you are over 16 you may be turned away from the Pizza table but will be able to partake in the Maha Prasad. Please remember that the order for food service will be **children, senior citizens and then all others. Please do not crowd the serving area.**

**We will have a table in the front foyer for registration (membership) for 2012.**

**Membership fee is \$151/- and those of you that have already paid will be given credit.**

**Annual pledges are at \$1500/- per year and you will be exempt from paying a**

**membership fee.** We sincerely request you to make a pledge. Any amount of donation above the membership fee will be accepted and you will be given a receipt for your records (for tax purposes). Please note that all other **cash contributions to the temple** be placed **directly in the Hundi** . If you contribute \$20/- or more at any time, please request a receipt from the priest and the money can be placed in the Hundi. **Only personal contributions specifically "intended for the priest" and not to the temple are to be given to the priest.**

Please make every effort to keep the premises clean and do not leave trash on the floor, carpet, and foyer or on the bathroom floor. We seek volunteers and you can sign up by writing your name on the volunteer list and providing us your Email/telephone number. If you have already done so please do not write your name again. Mrs. Koki Patel is our coordinator.
